

2025 University Wine Award: Call for Nominations

Please consider nominating candidates for the 2025 University Wine Award. The William E. Wine Award is given for a history of university teaching excellence in memory of William E. Wine, an alumnus and former rector of the Board of Visitors. Three awards of \$3000 are given each year.

Procedure: Nominations in each college are reviewed by respective College Wine nomination committees, which are comprised of Wine recipients or dean appointees in that College. Each College is allowed to put forward one nominee. The nominees from each College are then reviewed by the University Wine Award Committee, which selects the three award recipients each year.

Schedule:

- Fall: Nominees develop Dossiers according to Provost/ATE Guidelines. See link below for recorded Zoom workshop on dossier preparation.
- 5:00 p.m., January 10, 2025: Deadline for each candidate to submit their dossier to the College Wine Committee Chair listed below.
- Mid-January: Each College-level Wine Committee selects its nominee and notifies the nominee.
- 5:00 p.m., January 24, 2025: Each College-level Wine Committee Chair sends the e-Dossier of their nominee to the University Wine Committee Chair, Elisabeth Austin (elaustin@vt.edu).
- February: University Wine Committee selects recipients.
