
### **How to Import a Course Check-in Survey from Canvas Commons**


# Without the Direct Link to the Survey

- 1. Log in to your Virginia Tech Canvas account
- 2. On the left-hand side menu, find the Commons button.




3. In the search bar, type "Course Check-in Survey"





4. Click on the resource you want to import (either the open-ended or the rating scale version) and then select Import/Download on the right-hand side of the screen



5. Select the course(s) you want to import the survey into






6. Go into the course(s) you have imported the survey into and make any necessary edits.

### **How to Edit the Course Check-in Survey**

- 1. After you have imported the survey into your Canvas course, go to the course site and click on Quizzes. There you will see the survey you have just imported.
- 2. Click on the survey. Once it opens, click on the Edit button.



3. First make sure to edit the Details, which includes the instructions, settings (graded survey, ungraded), point values, etc.



4. Then, click on the Questions tab to make edits to the questions themselves. You will need to click on the pencil icon beside the question to edit the question itself.



Notes: If you are using the rating scale version and want to edit the options in the list, you will see a table format. Use the table controls to remove or add rows. If you add a new statement, you will need to provide a short descriptor in the next column.
